



ATHLETES CODE OF CONDUCT

The UNIQ Snowsport Athlete CODE OF CONDUCT has been put in place to ensure that all athletes feel comfortable, safe and happy to achieve their maximum potential in a positive team environment.

It is vitally important for the success of the club and the individual athlete achievements that the Code is respected and followed by all athletes on camp.

The Athlete code of conduct will be presented to each athlete at the start of every camp. This is to ensure that everyone is well aware of the level of behaviour we expect when representing UNIQ Snowsports.

Staff members include all management, coaches, house parents and academic tutors

- I. Athletes must listen and follow any instructions from a member of UNIQ Snowsports staff.
- II. Athletes must be considerate to others at all times, this includes members of the public.
- III. Athletes must not use bad language and use good manners at all times.
- IV. Athletes must not behave in a discriminatory manor towards anyone.
- V. Athletes must not commit any form of bullying. Physical, racial, mental or cyber bullying will not be tolerated.
- VI. Athletes must abide by the age group specific bed times.
- VII. Athletes must follow the Health & Safety rules and the FIS Skier's Code at all times.
- VIII. It is forbidden for athletes to enter a bedroom belonging to an athlete of the opposite sex at any time on camp.
- IX. Athletes are not allowed to engage in any sexual activity of any kind, including sexting.
- X. I will support and respect officials and volunteers involved in snowsport and understand participation in snowsport is only possible due to the time volunteers give freely to help myself and other children
- XI. I will support and respect my club members and other snowsport athletes
- XII. Alcohol, tobacco and any use of recreational or performance enhancing drugs must not be consumed at any time on camp.
- XIII. Medicinal drugs are only to be used with the full awareness of a member of UNIQ Snowsport staff.
- XIV. Under no circumstances are athletes allowed to leave the hotel / camp without the permission from a UNIQ Snowsports member of staff.
- XV. I know I am entitled to question decisions made in coaching, but I must do this appropriately and respectfully
- XVI. I will demonstrate sporting behavior at all times including competitions and decisions made
- XVII. I will demonstrate sporting behavior in all my activities and promote good sportsmanship, being modest in victory and gracious in defeat
- XVIII. I understand that disciplinary action may be imposed for breach of rules or for reasons of behavior. Any action will depend on the type and seriousness of any breach of rules or behavior, but will be accompanied by a verbal warning and/or a written warning as necessary.
