





## **DISCIPLINARY POLICY**

- I. UNIQ Snowsports recognises the responsibility to provide a safe, and secure environment for everyone to participate in Snowsport activities, whether this is as a child or adult learning the sport, a coach, instructor, committee member, parent, or anyone else involved in our club.
- II. To ensure UNIQ Snowsports continues to provide the above environment, we have set out the below procedure:

In cases of Misconduct UNIQ Snowsports will carry out a three-step discipline procedure:

- 1. Verbal warning
- 2. Written warning
- 3. **Dismissal** Uninvited to any future UNIQ camps / sending home from camp.

In cases of Gross Misconduct UNIQ Snowsports will carry out the following athlete disciplinary procedure;

- 1. Inform the parents of the current situation and that you will be looking into what has happened in more detail as soon as possible.
- 2. Establishing the facts with the athlete in question & others involved in any incidents.
- 3. To be carried out (where possible) by the club Manager with a CWO also present.
- 4. The aim is to establish what has happened, how it has happened and with whom it has happened.
- 5. Written documentation of any meetings will be recorded.

## **III.** Consequences:

- Does the consequence fit the misconduct?
- Report to SSE Safeguarding & Welfare officer where appropriate.
- Where removal from the program is likely, communicate with parents prior to athlete.
- If emails are to be sent to the full membership, use BCC.
- Athletes under the age of 18 will not be named on emails to the membership.
- **IV.** Misconduct could refer to but is not limited to: minor breaches of code of conduct, incidents that do not cause harm (of any kind) to oneself or another athlete.
  - Gross Misconduct could refer to but is not limited to: Endangering oneself or those around you, repeated breaches of code of conduct.
